God's Love For Man Brought About The Virgin Birth of Jesus, His Only Begotten Son

The Beginning of Man's Salvation From Eternal Death

My precious ones, we thank God for His love which cannot be measured by man. Your troubles and problems are all because you've failed to obey God — you've failed to love one another. His command is that you love another and to learn to love is to learn the will of God. He's done everything for us; He has blessed us in every way that one could hope to be blessed. He has filled the earth with goodness and He's given man wisdom and understanding that he might be able to develop and improve on nature's plan. He taught us how to change trees into boards and build beautiful little palaces, how to get stones out of the mountains and place them into the structures in which we live. But man has failed to take in the lessons that He sent His Son to teach — how to love another, to be not bitter one against another, seeking glory (vain glory) wherein there is no blessing. Jesus Christ came teaching the people the principles of the Kingdom of Heaven. They are found in the 5th Chapter of St. Matthew, on record in the Book we call the Bible. They are given to us that we might know the Lord Jesus, to Whom and through Whom God has revealed Himself.

This Son of God was given the name JESUS and the Scriptures declare in St. Matthew 1:21 the purpose of His coming which was to the end that men might learn how to deny ungodliness and live soberly and Godly in this present world. We are thankful for all who have learned because if they have, their whole pleasure and joy in life is to live so that they will cause someone else to know what God has taught them. Jesus came according to the promise of God, Who, through the angel Gabriel, sent the message of His coming into the world to Joseph to whom the Virgin Mary was espoused, that he might not put her away because she was found with child. Joseph thought that his virgin had been untrue, but it was the plan of God that He would bring into the world a Son, not by the help of man, but by the help of His own Spirit.

So when Joseph found Mary his espoused with child, and knowing the law which said, "If a woman has been untrue to her promise, she is to be stoned," (See Deuteronomy 22:21, Leviticus 20:10). And because he loved her, he didn't want her stoned and yet, he didn't desire to be the husband of an untrue woman, so he sought to put her away without it being known why he did it.

The Scriptures tell us in St. Matthew 1, verse 20, that while he thought on these things, an angel from heaven came to him. Read! "**But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph...**" Joseph thought on these things and while he was asleep, God sent an angel to him in a dream and in the dream, he heard, "**JOSEPH!**" Read! "**thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife; for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.**" That which is conceived in her is not by the cohabitation of her with another man. In the 21st verse he said, "**And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.**"

by your fore-parent, Adam, on account of his disobedience, are rebellious in your spirit and desire to have your own way, then the end of your way is death. But the end of the way that God has set before you is life. Not only here, but life everlasting.

The Lord said to Adam, "the day you disobey you shall die." He set in the Garden of Eden a tree which was no different from any other tree but it served as a line of demarcation between God and man. God had given man everything to enjoy, but the one thing He wanted man to do was to obey Him that he might continue to enjoy things. The Lord knew that the moment that man went contrary to His Commandments by committing sin that he wouldn't be able to control sin. You can't control sin. You may make all the laws you want to; you may build all the prisons you please and you may shoot the body, but the spirit to sin will move into another body. The only hope for us to escape the wages of sin which is death, is to be born again. Adam, who had the freedom of his will, was able to curse the human family by his disobedience to God because he was the progenitor of all men — the beginning of men. In fact, whether you believe it or not, the word 'Adam' means man. That same Adam who disobeyed God in the Garden is in you until you are born again. And when you are born again, that old Adam dies and the Begotten Son of God, Jesus Christ, will become alive in your life. It's strange isn't it? But the new birth is spiritual; it is of the mind; it is not a change of the body but a change of the mind. The mind is changed by one thing only and that is by the Word of God — (being born again.) In 1st Peter, the 1st Chapter and the 23rd verse, it tells you that you're born again not of corruptible seed but of an incorruptible seed by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth forever. I'll have it read for you. **"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."** It is done by the Word of God! Your mind is changed by hearing words! Did you know that? Words are spirits and whether they are of God or of the devil, they are powerful! But to hear the Word of God, which is given by the Spirit of God, will change your mind from a carnal purpose to a divine purpose.

My brother and my sister, just remember that Jesus Christ was given by God for a purpose just as the angel Gabriel told Joseph while he thought of putting away his wife, Mary. The Scriptures tell us that he was told not to fear to take her for his wife because that which was of her was by the Holy Spirit. And listen! Read St. Matthew

1:22: **"Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, .."** All this was done that God's Word might be fulfilled which was spoken of by the Lord through the Prophet Isaiah. And he said this in the 23d verse, **"Behold, a virgin shall be with child,..."** Notice! He said, "A virgin..." Don't talk about it being impossible! What's impossible with God? Huh! How can you conceive of your being here with the intelligence and wisdom that has been imparted unto you, without there being a God — somebody bigger than man? You can't do anything but breathe and when you stop breathing, your work is done under this sun.

Read: **"..and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us."** The babe who was born in Bethlehem and given the name JESUS was begotten by the Holy Spirit and therefore, having been begotten by the Holy Spirit, He became God with us in the flesh. And the 21st verse says what? **"And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins."** This is the purpose for which He came. He shall save them from disobedience, from that which destroyed the human family in Adam. God restored it in Christ that you and I, through Christ, might be born again and lose our carnal minds and have a divine mind as Adam had before he sinned!

When the angel left Joseph after having appeared to him in a dream, he went to Mary in person in the form and likeness of a human being. Angels can take on the natural appearance of a man. They are in fact, created just as you and I are created. The things that we do are done by the power of our minds, but the things that angels do are done by the power of the presence of God. Angels have the power of God with them wherever they go, as God has revealed and given to man the privilege and knowledge to

handle nature, that He might manifest to man His power. Do you know my precious ones that nature is God's hand? Do you know that electricity as we call it, is the power of nature? Do you know that everything is filled with electricity through nature, even your own body? You may walk across a piece of carpet and touch a piece of metal and from the end of your finger will come a spark of electricity. Did you know that if you should hold a piece of live wire, you wouldn't be able to turn it loose because you will be one in nature with God? Did you know that as the lightning flashes out of the East and shines into the West, that's how quickly God Himself, can move His Spirit beings? We move with our minds, but they move with power.

So here now we see Gabriel standing in the presence of the Virgin in person just after he left the man to whom she was espoused. He said these words found in the 28th verse of St. Luke 1 to her: **"And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: Blessed art thou among women."** God is sending a message from heaven — The Beginning of The Salvation Plan for man, fulfilling His own plan, spoken through the Prophet Isaiah, saying: **"A virgin shall conceive and bring forth a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel, being interpreted, God with us."** — (right with you!) He said, **"Hail, thou art highly favoured...among women."**

And what else? **"And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be"** (29). When Mary saw the angel standing in her doorway, she was troubled at his saying, and she wondered in her mind, who is this man, a stranger to me? What is he talking about? (The angel appeared in the form of a human being.) Read: **"And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary, for thou hast found favour with God."** And the angel answered her, "Fear not, Mary. Don't be afraid, God has made a choice of you. You are His favorite among women to do something! Read! **"And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS."** You shall conceive in your womb and bring forth a son, said Gabriel. Listen! He told Joseph that Mary, the woman to whom he was espoused, "shall bring forth a Son, His name shall be called JESUS, for He shall save His people from their sins." And now, he tells Mary, "you shall bring forth a son and His name shall be called JESUS. Then in the 32nd verse he said, **"He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of**

Birth and Childhood of Jesus

JOSEPH'S VISION

(St. Matthew 1:18-25)

"Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. But while he thought on these things, behold the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

"Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife: And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS."

BIRTH OF JESUS

St. Luke 2:1-7

"AND it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn."

THE VISIT OF THE SHEPHERDS

St. Luke 2:8-20

"And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the

city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men. And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.

"And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child. And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart. And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them."

JESUS CIRCUMCISED AND NAMED

St. Matthew 1:25; St. Luke 2:21

"And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS...And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb."

THE INFANT JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

St. Luke 2:22-40

"And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord; (As it is written in the law of the Lord. Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord;) And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the

law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons. And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him. And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against; (Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,) that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed. And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity; And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem. And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth. And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him."

Sunday School Lessons for the Month of December

The lessons for this month were reviewed by Elder David Green. He was a teacher of the junior boys class between 1994 and 2000 at the Church of God Sunday School, Newport News, VA.



LESSON 48 – December 1, 2019
SUBJECT: Prophecy of Jesus' Birth

GOLDEN TEXT: “And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David.” (St. Luke 1:31-32).

PRINTED SCRIPTURE TEXT: St. Luke 1:26 And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth,

27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.

28 And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women.

29 And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be.

30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?

35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

36 And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren.

37 For with God nothing shall be impossible.

38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. And the angel departed from her.

LESSON DISCUSSION

The angel, Gabriel, was dispatched from heaven to the city of Nazareth with a message for a young virgin named Mary (see Luke 1:26-27). Mary was troubled by his presence, and the angel told her not to be afraid, but that she was highly favored of God. (See Luke 1:29-30) Her mission was, that as a virgin, she would experience the birth of the long awaited Messiah, Jesus (see Luke 1:31). He would be known as the Son of the Highest, who would reign over an everlasting kingdom (see Luke 1:32-33).

Accepting this supernatural charge, Mary inquired further concerning this birth when she was not yet married (see Luke 1:34). Gabriel explained to her that the Holy Spirit would overshadow her, in which the child would be identified as the *Son of God* (see Luke 1:35). Also, the angel informed Mary that her cousin Elisabeth, who was past childbearing, was already in her sixth month of pregnancy, *noting that with God nothing shall be impossible* (see Luke 1:36-37). Submitting herself to the will of God, she stated, “*Be it unto me, according to thy word,*” (see Luke 1:38).

Like Mary, who had a humble attitude towards the entire encounter, today, God still uses ordinary people to carryout his divine objectives.

LESSON 49 – December 8, 2019
SUBJECT: Mary's Praise to God

GOLDEN TEXT: “And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed” (St. Luke 1:47-48).

PRINTED SCRIPTURE TEXT: St. Luke 1:39 And Mary arose in those days, and went into the hill country with haste, into a city of Juda; **40 And entered into the house of Zacharias, and saluted Elisabeth.**

41 And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost:

42 And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb.

43 And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?

44 For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy.

45 And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.

46 And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord,

47 And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

48 For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

49 For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is his name.

50 And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.

51 He hath shewed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

52 He hath put down the mighty from their seats, and exalted them of low degree.

53 He hath filled the hungry with good things; and the rich he hath sent empty away.

54 He hath helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy;

55 As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.

56 And Mary abode with her about three months, and returned to her own house.

LESSON DISCUSSION

In last week's lesson, the angel, Gabriel, not only informed Mary of the birth of the promised Messiah, but also of the anticipated birth of her cousin Elisabeth's child. Mary eagerly traveled from Nazareth to Judah to visit her cousin, Elisabeth (see Luke 1:39). As Mary entered Elisabeth's home Elisabeth could hear voice. Just then Elisabeth's baby leaped into her womb and she was filled with the Holy Ghost (see Luke 1:41).

Elisabeth began to acknowledge Mary as the mother of her Lord, and her baby leaped for joy inside her womb (see Luke 1:42-44). Elisabeth knew that Mary believed what she was told concerning her mission (see Luke 1:45). Mary responded by magnifying God and rejoicing in Him through a Psalm which displayed her knowledge of God's word, as she said, “*for he that is mighty hath done to me great things, and holy is his name.*” (See Luke 1:46-49). She continued to praise God for his strength, power and mercy to even those who are of a lowly state (see Luke 1: 50-55). After a period of three months, Mary returned to her home in Nazareth (see Luke 1:56). Even today, as with the case of Mary, God takes pleasure in using ordinary people.

LESSON 50 – December 15, 2019
SUBJECT: Birth of the Forerunner

GOLDEN TEXT: “And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways” (St. Luke 1:76).

PRINTED SCRIPTURE TEXT: St. Luke 1:57 Now Elisabeth's full time came that she should be delivered; and she brought forth a son.

58 And her neighbours and her cousins heard how the Lord had shewed great mercy upon her; and they rejoiced with her.

59 And it came to pass, that on the eighth day they came to circumcise the child; and they called him Zacharias, after the name of his father.

60 And his mother answered and said, Not so; but he shall be called John.

61 And they said unto her, There is none of thy kindred that is called by this name.

62 And they made signs to his father, how he would have him called.

63 And he asked for a writing table, and wrote, saying, His name is John. And they marvelled all.

64 And his mouth was opened immediately, and his tongue loosed, and he spake, and praised God.

67 And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying,

68 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,

69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

70 As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;

72 To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;

73 The oath which he swore to our father Abraham,

74 That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,

75 In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.

76 And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways;

77 To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins,

78 Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

79 To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

LESSON DISCUSSION

Elisabeth's time had come to give birth, and she gave birth to a boy. (See Luke 1:57). Friends and relatives rejoiced over the delivery because God had showed mercy at a time in her life when she was past childbearing (see Luke 1:58). The baby was circumcised and the people assumed that he would be named after the father, but Elisabeth informed them that the baby would be named **John** (see Luke 1:59-60). The family noted that no one in the family had that name. They consulted Zacharias for confirmation. Zacharias was rendered speechless by the archangel Gabriel from the time that Elisabeth had conceived (see Luke 1:19-20). Zacharias could only write his response, in which he said "**His name is John**" (see Luke 1:61-63).

It was then that Zacharia's tongue was loosened and he began praising God, as the Holy Ghost fell upon him. He prophesied about the **horn of salvation** which identified the coming of the Messiah as powerful and glorious, freeing His people out of the hands of their enemies to serve God righteously (see Luke 1:64, 67-75). He also understood that his son John would be the **prophet of the Highest**, to go before Jesus to prepare the way for the people to find salvation to bring light into a darkened world (see Luke 1:76-79).

LESSON 51 – December 22, 2019

SUBJECT: Birth of the Saviour (Christmas)

GOLDEN TEXT: "And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn" (St. Luke 2:7).

PRINTED SCRIPTURE TEXT: St. Luke 2:1 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be taxed.

2 (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.)

3 And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

5 To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

6 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

7 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

12 And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,

14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

LESSON DISCUSSION

. The Roman government was registering the people for taxation purposes, and Joseph travelled with his pregnant wife Mary to the town of his ancestry which was Bethlehem (see Luke 2:1-5). While they were there, Mary gave birth to Jesus, wrapping him in **swaddling clothes**, which were strips of cloth. She laid her baby in a manger, which was a feeding trough for animals (see Luke 2:6-7).

Meanwhile, in a separate location, shepherds were monitoring their flock by night, when an angel of God appeared and frightened them (See Luke 2:8-9). The angel told them not to fear—and presented them with the good news of the birth of the Savior in Bethlehem, wrapped in swaddling clothes lying in a manger. (See Luke 2:10-12). Following the announcement, a heavenly host of angels appeared in the sky and they said, "**Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will towards men**" (see Luke 2:13-14).

It is through the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ that even today, we, too can have peace on earth, no matter what trouble surrounds this world.

LESSON 52 – December 29, 2019

SUBJECT: Forsaking All to Follow Him

GOLDEN TEXT: "And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him" (St. Luke 5:11).

PRINTED SCRIPTURE TEXT: St. Luke 5:1 And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret,

2 And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing their nets.

3 And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

4 Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

5 And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.

6 And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

7 And they beckoned unto their partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.

8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

9 For he was astonished, and all that were with him, at the draught of the fishes which they had taken:

10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

11 And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him.


LESSON DISCUSSION

Jesus found himself surrounded by a large crowd of people who were anxious to hear the word of God, at the lake of Gennesaret (see Luke 5:1). To escape the crowd, He noticed two empty fishing boats, where the fishermen were washing their nets (see Luke 5:2). Jesus entered one of the boats belonging to Simon Peter, and He asked him to sail the boat a little ways from the shoreline so He continue teaching the people (see Luke 5:3).

After he finished teachings, he asked Peter to sail further out and cast his nets for some fish (see Luke 5:4) Peter complained about spending the night fishing and receiving nothing. Although Peter was not happy he agreed to obey Jesus. (see Luke 5:5). To their surprise, the fishermen caught so many fish, that the net began to break. They called for the men in the second boat to assist them, and they caught so many fish that their boats began to sink from the weight (see Luke 5:6-7).

Amazed by the harvest and recognizing his lack of faith, Peter fell down at Jesus' knees and asked Him to depart from him, feeling unworthy of his company (See Luke 5:8-9). Jesus said to him, "**Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.**" From that point, Peter and those fellow fishermen left their fishing occupation and became followers of Jesus (see Luke 5:10-11).

Proverbs 11:30 says, "**The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.**" We who have received Christ Jesus as Lord and Savior, have the power to lead those who are lost to Him.
