Is A Woman Who Destroys Her Children BeforeThey Are Born A Murderer?

I am going to have read to you one passage from which I shall take my text. It is Jeremiah 2:34 which reads as follows: "Also in thy skirts is found the blood of the souls of the poor innocents: I have not found it by secret search, but upon all these."

My subject tonight is this: "Is A Woman Who Destroys Her Children Before They Are Born a Murderer?"

Spirits rule the flesh. They make you run or walk. They make you happy or sad. They make you go or come. Whatever you do, a spirit guides you in doing it. If it is a bad spirit, you'll do evil things, and the flesh becomes evil. If it is a good spirit, you'll do good things, and the flesh becomes righteous.

Women have various reasons for wishing to prevent conception. In the first place, they are ignorant of the purpose of marriage. They don't realize that God made male and female to be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth and subdue it. They don't realize that bearing children is the principle purpose of entering into the marriage relationship, and that every other duty of the female is an outgrowth of this one.

Motherhood Considered Burdensome

Moreover, another reason for wishing to prevent conception is that children are considered a burden to women today. Besides the embarrassments and inconveniences of bearing them, there is the added trouble of caring for them during their infancy and the problem of shaping their future as they grow up. To assume these responsibilities the young mother is required to give up a great deal of pleasure and spend most of her time in her home with her offspring.

In some cases, poverty is given as a reason for wishing to prevent conception, in still other cases women undertake to limit the number of children, feeling that after they have given birth to a certain number they should quit. Altogether, women have pretty much taken the matter into their own hands, ignoring, or disregarding the divine purpose of marriage and misunderstanding the privilege of bearing children.

After God joined male and female in holy matrimony, He ordered them to be fruitful and multiply and replenish (or fill) the earth (with people). In this He delegated to the male and female the honor of creating the rest of the folks of this world. He, therefore, adjusted things so that by this means and this means only could people come into existence. So, when a woman destroys her child, she thwarts God's plans and thereby falls into condemnation.

Blood Is The Life Of Human Beings

Now I am going to show you that life is blood and not flesh. In Leviticus 17:12-13 and 14a which reads as follows we see that blood is life: "Therefore I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood. And whatsoever man there be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten; he shall even pour out the blood thereof and cover it with dust. For it is the life of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life thereof..."

The children of Israel were forbidden to eat or drink blood of anything they killed for food. They were instructed to empty the blood on the ground and cover it. In Genesis 4:10 when God was investigating the first murder, He said: "And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me **from the ground**." It was the blood of Jesus Christ that gave us eternal life. If you shed blood in destroying flesh, according to Genesis 9:5, you are a murderer and will be punished as such. Read it! "And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man."

Since woman was commanded by God to bear children, it should be a pleasure for her to do so. This command, functioning in its orderly channel causes the woman to desire to fondle and pet something even if it has to be a dog. The most unbecoming thing to see is a woman mothering a dumb beast. I cannot see how a woman can get her mouth in shape to kiss a dog and yet this is a common thing among women who do not have children. The instinct to fondle and to love when not degenerated will cause the woman to bear a child. This is natural affection and natural affection will cause you to do natural things. Then when you realize that you are to become a mother, instead of dreading the ordeal or wishing to prevent it, you will appreciate the honor of bearing a child. If a woman loves her husband, she will want to bear him children. And by all means, the children will favor their daddy. A child doesn't have any business favoring anybody but the daddy or mother. And if the parents love each other, it will.

Children Are A Blessing To Any Home Poor Or Rich

The wife should also realize the children are a blessing from God. When God gets ready to bless you, He does it by giving you children. If He wants to pour out a large blessing, He gives you many children. You should by all means receive what He gives you in a spirit of cheerful gratitude. Suppose my Mother had not wished to have any children and I had not been born, you wouldn't be here tonight praising God. I want you to know that children are a blessing. Read Psalm 128:3, 4: "Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine"

house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table. Behold that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the LORD."

When you are old and somewhat feeble and someone comes to take advantage of you, you can look around and call your sons one by one - Sam! George! Nathaniel! John! William, come here, and they'll rush eagerly to lift you up and protect you. Besides, there is an inward satisfaction to enjoy when you realize that you have done your part in peopling the earth.

I have shown that the primary purpose of marriage is to bear children. I have shown that to bear children is to do the will of God. I have shown that blood is life, and consequently to spill blood is to take life. In showing that blood is life, I have revealed (contrary to general opinion) that you cannot kill the flesh except by spilling the blood or by destroying its properties. Now I will show that every child's birth is designated and ordained by God. This will make it evident that a woman who destroys her children before they are born is a murderer.

The child's life is molded by the disposition and habits of the parent while it is developing. If one child is sweet and pleasant and the other mean and hateful, it is because the mother was sweet and pleasant during pregnancy with the one and mean and hateful with the other. If the mother would realize how important her work is in shaping the destiny of her offspring, she would be more careful in subduing her wayward inclinations and allowing a sweet spirit to rule her at least during this delicate period.

Although man and woman are instruments or agencies by which other human beings come into existence, it is known that God is the actual giver of life and of every good and perfect gift. Man, plants the seed but God raises the crop. Before the human seed of life is planted, God takes note of it, and arranges for its existence and career. He even names it by putting the idea in the mind of the parents. Read Jeremiah 1:5: "Before I formed thee in the belly, I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations." Also read St. Luke 1:13: "But the angel said unto him, Fear not Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard, and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John."

Since this is true, we can see how deplorable it is for man to propose to do something that is grossly contrary to God's plan and purpose. We can see that after He has sent the life-giving fluid into proper channels and ordained that it should become a human being of specific descriptions, it is a terrible thing to thwart His plan and terminate the life by causing the blood to flow or be spilled.

Stop and Repent

We have seen that it is God's intention that man and woman marry while they are young and bear children if they are not barren. God does not desire and will not allow women to interfere with the orderly processes of nature. If you have been doing so, I exhort you to repent, that is, **STOP!** For by destroying your unborn child, you make yourself as much a murderer as the man who thrusts a dagger into another's heart without justification or excuse. Whether the unborn child has formed or not, if blood has ceased to flow because of impregnation, and you start the flow again with the intention of interfering with the process of nature, you are guilty, and God will judge you as a murderer.

How terrible it will be when you face the judgment and hear Him say, "The voice of thy children's blood crieth unto me from the ground."

May God bless you.

THE SUMMER 2022 - SOLEMN ASSEMBLY

Fasting is a vital aspect of true worship. It is not a time for feasting, fun, pious acting, or bowing to one's self to appear sanctimonious. The period of Prayer, Meditation, Worship and Fasting represents serious time spent with the Lord. During this time of consecration, the Believer afflicts the body while seeking to gain strength for the inner man.

From Friday, July 8th through Sunday, July 17, 2022, Gospel Spreading Church engages in a Solemn Assembly. COVID-19 guidelines suggest radical change in corporate worship. Modern technology such as webinars and smart phones replace regular church gatherings. Gospel Spreading Church members presently engage in the worship experience while sheltering in place.

Praise God for His faithfulness. Since in life we sometimes find ourselves in difficulties that help us recognize the fact that we need God to work out our situations. Problems are no strangers to us. Life's situations are not always understood, and may be very hard to unravel.

In Bible days, when people of God found themselves facing insurmountable odds they called on God. For example, Queen Esther called the people to prayer and fasting (See Esther 4:16). The city of Nineveh was called to fasting and prayer (See Jonah 3:5). When the disciples were unable to cast demons out of the child, Jesus informed them of the necessity of prayer and fasting. "Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting" (St. Matthew 17:21).

The procedure for corporate prayer and fasting is outlined in Joel 2:15-17. In these worship services every detail is given. Everyone from the greatest to the least is to be accounted for. The people are gathered, the congregation is to be cleansed/sanctified. The elders, children, nursing babies, bride, bridegroom, priests, ministers of the Lord are to be assembled. No one is left out.

Just as the prophet Joel explains corporate prayer and fasting, the prophet Isaiah exhorts the church to fast individually. "Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh" (Isaiah 58:6,7)?

Corporate and individual prayer and fasting are often major factors in true worship. We receive great things from the Lord when we obey His instructions regarding how to worship. "Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward" (Isaiah 58:8).

Just as prayer and fasting were practices in the Old Testament, and the New Testament, they are important elements in worshiping God in this 21st century. Isaiah truly cried aloud and spared not. He declared unto us what is the acceptable fast unto the Lord. We should not withhold good when we have such an opportunity.

Jesus taught His followers how to conduct themselves when in prayer and fasting. He said, "But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face; That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly" (St. Matthew 6:17, 18).

We also follow the exhortation found in I Timothy 2:1-4: "I EXHORT therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth." In this regard, during the solemn assembly, special prayers are offered for the President of the United States, his staff, members of the U.S. Congress, judges of the earth and the Armed Forces. Second Chronicles 7:14: "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." As a nation, and as individuals, we need to turn from our wicked ways. If this is done, God will heal our land.

We are living in a time of trouble, such as never was since there has been a nation. However, we can always find comfort in the Scriptures. Psalm 84:11: "For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. Regardless of the circumstances, God will honor His Word, if we will obey Him to the letter. "For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us" (II Corinthians 1:20)

Sunday School Lessons for the Month of July

The lessons for this month were reviewed by Elder Dr. Anthony Hurst, Sr. of the Church of God, Philadelphia, PA.



LESSON 27 – July 3, 2022 SUBJECT: Haggai Calls for Faithful Service

GOLDEN TEXT: "Then came the word of the Lord by Haggai the prophet, saying, is it time for you, O ye, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house lie waste?" (Haggai 1:3-4).

PRINTED TEXT: Haggai 1:1 In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, in the first day of the month, came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet unto Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, saying,

- 2 Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, This people say, The time is not come, the time that the LORD's house should be built.
- 3 Then came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet, saying,
- 4 Is it time for you, O ye, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house lie waste?
- 5 Now therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your ways.
- 6 Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes.
- 7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your ways.
- 8 Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.
- 9 Ye looked for much, and, lo it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.
- 10 Therefore the heaven over you is stayed from dew, and the earth is stayed from her fruit.
- 11 And I called for a drought upon the land, and upon the mountains, and upon the corn, and upon the new wine, and upon the oil, and upon that which the ground bringeth forth, and upon men, and upon cattle, and upon all the labour of the hands.

LESSON DISCUSSION

This minor prophet with a major message has a name not found anywhere else in Scripture. His name means 'festal one,' possibly indicating he was born on a feast day. This passage contains the first of four prophecies, directed to Zerubbabel, in the lineage of Jesus and governor of Israel, and Joshua, the high priest, descended from Aaron, who was over the religious life of the people. In 538 BC 50,000 Jews returned from Babylon to Jerusalem under the order of Cyrus the Persian. They began rebuilding the temple two years later but stopped due to persecution from their enemies and disinterest.

In 520 BC, God raised up Haggai, along with Zechariah to challenge the people to finish rebuilding the temple and to reorder their spiritual priorities. Twice Haggai says, "Consider your ways!" They were indicted for building their own houses and allowing the temple to lie in ruins, thus failing to bring glory to God!

Today, God still calls us to consider our ways. Do all of our funds go to making our homes comfortable while the church building lies in disrepair? Is everything around you breaking down? Sometimes this is an indication of misplaced priorities.

The New Testament instructs us to give as God has prospered us (See I Corinthians 16:2), with a tithe being the starting place. God wants us to give cheerfully and willingly (See II Corinthians 8.) Verse 6 is a clear indication of what can happen to us today if our priorities are not in order!!!

LESSON 28 – July 10, 2022 SUBJECT: Micah Stands Firm for God

GOLDEN TEXT: "The Lord knows the days if the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever" (Psalm 37:18).

PRINTED TEXT: Micah 2:4 In that day shall one take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, and say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed it from me!

turning away he hath divided our fields.

- 5 Therefore thou shalt have none that shall cast a cord by lot in the congregation of the LORD.
- 6 Prophesy ye not, say they to them that prophesy: they shall not prophesy to them, that they shall not take shame.
- 7 O thou that art named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? are these his doings? do not my words do good to him that walketh uprightly?
- 8 Even of late my people is risen up as an enemy: ye pull off the robe with the garment from them that pass by securely as men averse from war.
- 9 The women of my people have ye cast out from their pleasant houses; from their children have ye taken away my glory for ever.
- 10 Arise ye, and depart; for this is not your rest: because it is polluted, it shall destroy you, even with a sore destruction.
- 11 If a man walking in the spirit and falsehood do lie, saying, I will prophesy unto thee of wine and of strong drink; he shall even be the prophet of this people.

LESSON DISCUSSION

Although very little is known about the prophet Micah, his name means "Who is like the LORD?" Nothing is known about his parents or his birthplace. His ministry was mostly to the northern kingdom of Israel, which was about to fall to the Assyrians in 722 B.C. Micah's prophecies were during the reigns of Jotham (750-731 B.C.), Ahaz (731-715 B.C.), and Hezekiah (715-686 B.C.), all kings of the southern kingdom of Judah.

He prophesied against the wickedness going on in society as well as the corruption in the religious life of the nation. The Old Testament prophets always called Israel back to the worship of the true and living God when they went astray, and Micah is no different. In Chapter 1, Micah condemns the nation for its sins against God, breaking the first commandment to have no other god but God. They played the spiritual harlot worshipping the idols of the heathen.

In Chapter 2 Micah speaks to the nation about their sins against each other. They took property from others by force. Because of their sins, Micah prophesied that Judah would fall to the Babylonians, which took place in 586 B.C.

All that Micah spoke about is present in our world today, and more besides. But God says the same to us today as He said then: "He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God" (Micah 6:8).

LESSON 29 – July 17, 2022 SUBJECT: Habakkuk Praises God's Faithfulness

GOLDEN TEXT: "Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation" (Habakkuk 3:18).

PRINTED TEXT: Habakkuk 2:1 I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.

- 2 And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.
- 3 For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.
- 4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.
- 5 Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, he is a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people: 3:17 Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls:
- 18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.
- 19 The LORD God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.

LESSON DISCUSSION

Not much is known about Habakkuk. The book opens with "The burden which the prophet Habakkuk dis see" (Habakkuk 1:1). giving indication that he might have been well known to his audience. His name means "one who embraces." This might be appropriate as will be pointed out by the end of this lesson. He was contemporary with Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, and Zephaniah.

He prophesied during the end of the Assyrian Empire and the beginning of the Babylonian Empire, giving a timeframe of the late 7th century B.C. There was very little justice. Violence was rampant, and all kinds of wickedness was ongoing with no challenge. Habakkuk cried out to God in Habakkuk 1:2-4, asking why God had not answered his prayers.

In our text today, Habakkuk decided to wait for the Lord's reply to his prayer. He was essentially powerless to physically right the wrongs that he saw, but He knew it was nothing God could not handle. God answered him and had him to write what He said, because it would surely come to pass! Habakkuk 2:4 compares the life of the wicked (one who is proud with a soul detached from God), and the just (one who lives by faith that is anchored in God!)

Habakkuk makes a remarkable and noteworthy statement in chapter 3:17-19. He proclaims that regardless to how bad things get, yet he would rejoice in the LORD God, who is his strength.

This is a much-needed lesson in our modern times. The problems of life crash down around us.

LESSON 30 – July 24, 2022 SUBJECT: Ezekiel Brings Hope to Israel

GOLDEN TEXT: "And [I] shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and i shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the Lord have spoken it, and performed it, saith the Lord" (Ezekiel 37:14).

PRINTED TEXT: Ezekiel 37:1 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,

- 2 And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, there were very many in the open valley; and, lo, they were very dry.
- 3 And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord God, thou knowest.
- 4 Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.
- 5 Thus saith the Lord GoD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:
- 6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- 7 So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.
- 8 And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.
- 9 Then said he unto me, Prophesy unto the wind, prophesy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord God; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.
- 10 So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army.
- 11 Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost: we are cut off for our parts.
- 12 Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God; Behold, O my people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.
- 13 And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,
- 14 And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken it, and performed it, saith the LORD.

LESSON DISCUSSION

Ezekiel's name means "strengthened by God." He was contemporary with Jeremiah, Daniel, and Zechariah. Ezekiel and his wife were brought to Babylon along with a group of about 10,000 captives in 597 B.C., seven years before the fall of Judah, the southern kingdom. He was around the age of 25 at this time, and he functioned as both a prophet and a priest.

He spoke to Israel by means of prophecies and illustrations. There were also false prophets who spoke of the nation's early restoration to its land that were dispelled by the fall of Judah in 586 B.C.

Our text is one concerning the future restoration of the nation. In spite of the people worshiping idols, eating meat with blood, committing adultery, and trusting in their own strength (See Ezekiel 33:25), and in spite of God's judgment against violators of His law (See Ezekiel 33:27), God's grace shines through brighter than the noonday sun!

Ezekiel is brought by the Spirit to this valley filled with dry bones, signifying the spiritually dead nation, God asks Ezekiel "... can these bones live" Ezekiel 37:3)?

As Ezekiel obeyed the voice of the LORD, the bones came together and lived!!! God was promising the yet future restoration of the nation of Israel (See Romans 9:11.)

If God promised to deliver Israel, His covenant people, from their sins, will He not do the same for those who He has made part of the church, the body of Christ? James tells us "**Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you**" (James 4:8a).

LESSON 31 – July 31, 2022 SUBJECT: James Heals a Centurion's Servant

GOLDEN TEXT: "When Jesus hear these things, he...said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel" (St Luke 7:9).

PRINTED TEXT: St. Luke 7:1 Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

- 2 And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.
- 3 And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.
- 4 And when they came to Jesus, they be sought him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom he should do this:
- 5 For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue.
- 6 Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:
- 7 Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.
- 8 For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.
- 9 When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.
- 10 And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.

LESSON DISCUSSION

Gentile from Syrian Antioch. He is the only Gentile to write a portion of the Word of God. While Paul wrote most of the epistles in the New Testament (12 or 13), Luke wrote the most by volume. He also accompanied Paul on much of his missionary journeys.

Our text today, which is also found in St. Matthew 8:5-13, concerns a request by a Roman centurion on behalf of his servant who was deathly ill. This event takes place in the city of Capernaum, where Jesus went to live when He left His hometown of Nazareth (See St. Matthew 4:12-16).

This same city would later be thoroughly and eternally condemned by Jesus for its unbelief (St. Matthew 8:11-13). This man expressed love for Israel by building a synagogue for them as compared to the hatred the Jews expressed toward Gentiles (See St. Luke 4:24-30). This man called Jesus "Lord," in St. Luke 7:6, something Paul said could only be done through the Holy Spirit (See I Corinthians 12:13).

This Gentile military official expressed such faith in Jesus as opposed to the lack of faith in Israel, that Jesus marveled, the only time in the gospels this is spoken of Him!!! God honors faith because faith honors God (Hebrews 11)!!!


Compare your faith in Christ to that expressed by this Gentile man. Ask God to forgive where you fall short and ask Him to help you to fully trust Him in every situation of life!
